

AOG ENERGY: Knowledge Forum Call for Speakers

RINA Stream Offshore Marine Technology

Each year, AOG Energy hosts a free-to-attend conference program alongside the exhibition. The Knowledge Forum is a dedicated stream that forms part of the wider conference program. It brings together specialised sectors to discuss the latest technologies, innovations and challenges currently being faced by the industry.

In 2024, the Royal Institution of Naval Architects (RINA) are hosting a whole day of the Knowledge Forum covering Offshore Marine Technology.

We are seeking speakers to give a 20-minute presentation, with 5 minutes of dedicated question time at the end. No written papers are required.

SESSION TOPICS

- Offshore Operations: fixed and floating offshore structures, ships for offshore operations, offshore installations.
- Autonomous Systems: Autonomous ships, surface and underwater vehicles, design and applications for transportation, marine operations and inspections.
- Green Shipping: New fuels, energy efficiency, alternative propulsion, application of recent regulations.
- Maritime Applications of Data Science: examples of application of data science to the design, construction, operation and integrity management of ships and offshore systems.

SUBMISSION CRITERIA

- Presentation title
- Speaker name
- Session name (to be chosen from the session topics)
- Abstract (maximum 300 words) for the presentation
- Speaker bio (maximum 200 words) including the speaker's history of involvement with the chosen topic
- Approved company clearance to present the material

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Submissions will be evaluated based on their technical content, innovation and relevance to the offshore industry
- Submissions referring to case studies will be highly regarded
- Prior to submission, company and joint venture clearance must be obtained
- Ideally your submission will not have been presented before and should contain new information

Two presentations will be selected for each of the session topics and will be evaluated based on their technical content, innovation and relevance to the offshore industry.

Submissions are due 13 October 2023.
